5 SCHOLARSHIPS RESERVED TO TRENTINO EMIGRANTS DESCENDANTS TO ATTEND THE UNIVERSITY OF TRENTO ACADEMIC YEAR 2026/2027

The Autonomous Province of Trento, in collaboration with the University of Trento and the Opera Universitaria of Trento ¹, is organizing a selection process for the awarding of **5 scholarships** to descendants of Trentino emigrants living abroad, for the purpose of attending the University of Trento (Unicolor Project).

The scholarships are divided as follows

- 2 scholarships for bachelor degree courses (1st level degree – 3 years); -
- 3 scholarships for master's degree courses (2nd level degree – 2 years).

The annual amount of the scholarship is quantified as follows:

- residents in countries belonging to the European Union: euro 6,700.00; -
- residents in countries outside the European Union: euro 7,250.00.

Other benefits:

- free accommodation at a University Camp;
- exempt from the payment of university fees;
- refund on the fee to register for National Health Insurance.

Applicants requirements:

- descendants of Trentino emigrants living abroad;
- applicants must have been admitted to one of the 1st or 2nd level programs of study at the University of Trento

To be admitted to the selection:

- fill in and sign the application form available on the website

- Attach the following documents:
 - copy of passport - only the pages relating to personal data - or identity document;
 - curriculum vitae and studiorum in Europass format (please refer to <https://europass.cedefop.europa.eu/>);
 - a short motivation letter – maximum 3000 characters including spaces - in Italian or English language in which the candidate argues the choice made;
 - copy of any further international certification of computer and language skills;
 - documentation attesting to the positive preliminary assessment (or admission following selection by announcement) or documentation of the request for preliminary assessment/selection for admission to the chosen degree course;
 - any documentation attesting a situation of serious financial hardship of the applicant

and of the family, adequately verified by an Italian diplomatic Institution or by a competent social service of the country of residence, with legalized signature by the competent Italian diplomatic Institution. This documentation must contain every possible element of evaluation - verifiable by the Province or by the Consultore (2)

- of the Province - on the economic and patrimonial situation of the applicant and of the relative family, compared to the minimum salaries or pensions recurring in the country of origin.

The Province and the University of Trento will proceed, in concert, to assign the scores to the eligible applications as follows, for a maximum of 100 points:

EVALUATION CRITERIA	POINTS AWARDED
Curriculum vitae and personal preparation requirements	0 – 20
Curriculum studiorum: relevance of academic training and extra-academic activities (internships, summer schools, conferences) with the objectives and characteristics of the chosen program of study	0 – 50
Motivation letter in which the choice made is argued	0 – 20
Certified serious financial hardship	5
Additional score in case the candidate is the only one from his/her family to participate in the selection or if the candidate's family has never received scholarships from the same project	5

The annual grant awarded to the winners will run from October, 1st 2026 to September, 30th 2027. The scholarship may be renewed annually for the normal duration of the program, subject to verification of the merit requirements. A further six-monthly renewal of the scholarship will be granted to only those students who will be awaiting graduation within the regular duration of the course of study.
